

NOTICE TO ALL POTENTIAL RESPONDENTS

The vendor questions and answers listed below are in direct relation to the following Request for Proposal: **Peaseburg Little People's Park – Park Design and Installation**. This addendum is released on February 25th, 2019 and officially updates, replaces, removes or clarifies certain portions of the City's issued Request for Proposal. Additional details are listed below.

VENDOR QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. Will the grade change on the site?

A. No, it will remain consistent.

Q. Will the contract include demolition?

A. No, the City will handle demolition of equipment, existing concrete and fencing.

Q. Will the contract include seeding or sod?

A. No, City will cover.

Q. What type of playground surface?

A. Loose fiber playground mulch.

Q. Will the contract include landscaping?

A. No, City will handle landscaping.

Q. Will the fitness equipment be within the playground area?

A. No, the fitness equipment should be separate due to use zone requirements.

Q. Can the adjacent parking lot be used as a staging area?

A. The City will work with the Fire Union to grant access.

Q. How should construction be stored on site?

A. In a locked storage unit to avoid theft.

Q. Will there be access to water or electric?

A. No.

VENDOR QUESTIONS & ANSWERS, CONT.

Q. Should the park design account for ADA accessibility?

A. Yes.

Q. What is your color preference?

A. Blue and green.

Q. Is recycled equipment okay?

A. If it is durable and high-grade material.

Q. Do you have any similar parks in the system to view for reference?

A. Father Hanses Park at 11th and Hermes.

Q. Will the benches require footers?

A. Yes, concrete.

Q. Would you like to include fabric under mulch and an edger?

A. Yes.

Q. Who will treat for weeds pre-install?

A. The City.

Q. Has the City done a study on the site?

A. No, parcel boundaries and topo are publically available on Link GIS.

Q. Where might I find information about the performance bond associated with this project?

A. A performance bond will not be required as part of the Proposal submission, but may be required upon selection for award.
