Said bid shall be enclosed in an envelope, marked with the aforementioned project name, and must be delivered to and time stamped by the **FIRST FLOOR WINDOW FINANCE DEPARTMENT, 20 WEST PIKE STREET, COVINGTON, KY 41011** no later than **10:00 a.m.**, prevailing time, **December 20, 2016** and will be opened and read in public by the City Clerk, or her alternate, at that time and date in the 1st floor Commission Chambers, 20 W. Pike Street, Covington, KY 41011.

Said bids will be tabulated and referred to the City Manager for recommendations to the City Commission. The City Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The owner reserves the right to waive any informalities.

Bids submitted for this project shall include all material, labor, equipment and installation required to complete all element(s). Each sealed bid shall be accompanied by either a cashier's check or satisfactory bid bond, in a sum, which is not less than five (5%) percent of the aggregate amount of the bid, payable to the City of Covington. Successful bidder will be required to execute and to provide construction contract security in an amount no less than one hundred percent of the bid. All bids must be made on the required Bid Form. Two completed copies of the Bid Form are required.

This project is subject to the Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Kentucky Department of Labor.

The City will evaluate all submitted bids in accordance with resident bidder preferences pursuant to KRS 45A.490-494. The City of Covington reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to negotiate with the apparent qualified bidder to such extent as may be determined by the Engineers recommendations to the City.
