The following conditions and/or operations are being reported for highways in District Six for March 5, 2010. Changes and/or additions from last report are underlined.

BOONE COUNTY

- **North Bend Road (KY 237) from I-275 to Kara Lane** – As construction continues on this project, please be aware of changing traffic alignments and please watch for work crews along North Bend Road (KY 237) and the entrance and exit ramps to/from I-275. Please follow all traffic control signs and markings as posted. On this project, please watch for flaggers and be aware of trucks entering and exiting the highway. Traffic may be periodically stopped through this area to allow equipment to pass. Motorists are advised the speed limit has been reduced to 35 MPH through this area. Expect delays particularly during rush hour periods.

CAMPBELL COUNTY

- **I-275 – Combs Hehl Bridge** – The following is the schedule for the repair work that is being performed on the Combs Hehl Bridge on March 5, 6 and 7, 2010. If all goes accordingly, this will be the final weekend, weather permitting, of the project. All restrictions will be lifted and typical traffic patterns will resume after work is complete.

East Bound

9:00 am – 3:30 pm Friday – Single Left Lane Closure

7:00 pm Friday to 9:00 am Saturday - Single Left Lane Closure

9:00 pm Friday to 9:00 am Saturday - Total Closure

Westbound

6:00 pm Friday to 8:00 pm Saturday – Single Left lane Closure

8:00 pm Saturday to 10:00 am Sunday – Total Closure

10:00 am Sunday to 11:00 pm Sunday – Single Right Lane Closure

- **US 27 (Falmouth to Newport Road)** – Road Construction has begun on US 27. The work zone will encompass the area between Parkside Drive and Nagel Road (West); immediate construction activities will begin approximately ½ mile south of Hillview Drive. Watch for traffic control devices and construction equipment entering and leaving the roadway. The speed limit throughout the work-zone will be reduced to 45 MPH.

GRANT COUNTY

- **I-75 @ MP 143-152 Northbound & Southbound –**
All 3 lanes are open for Southbound I-75. Two lanes of traffic will remain on Northbound I-75 until construction resumes this spring. The speed limit will remain at 55 mph through the work zone as this area remains an active work zone until final completion this year. Please watch for slow traffic and construction vehicles entering or leaving the area.
- **US 25 Bridge over the NS Railroad in Williamstown -** Existing Bridge is open to vehicular traffic. Utility work has started and bridge work is expected to start March 1st. Some construction traffic will be entering the roadway on US 25, but one lane in each direction will remain open. Fill material will be transported from the I-75 Interchange at Williamstown. Completion of project is expected August 1st of 2011.

HARRISON COUNTY

- **US 27 Bridge over the CSX Railroad in Cynthiana -** Existing Bridge is open to vehicular traffic. Truck traffic is being detoured via Church Street. Truck detour is marked. Some construction traffic will be entering the roadway on US 27, but one lane in each direction will remain open. Main Street Connector construction has begun as well as utility work. Completion of project is expected in summer of 2011.

KENTON COUNTY

- **I-75 Northbound M.P. 189 (at an existing KYTC Detention Basin)**
Beginning the week of March 8, 2010 through the remainder of the year, trucks may be entering and leaving the highway at various times via the right shoulder approximately 0.5 miles north of the Kyles Lane overpass, and approximately 2.5 miles south of the Ohio River. Use caution, Watch for trucks and police escorts using the right shoulder.
- **I-75 Southbound M.P. 181.26 and 180.11 (Bridge Bearing Painting)**
There will be a right shoulder closure on I-75 SB at MP 181.26 (KY 18 over I-75) and MM 180.11 (US 42 over I-75) until April 1, 2010 for the I-75 bridge painting project. Motorists are advised to use caution when approaching the work zone.
- **I-75/71 Northbound and Southbound at MP 188 -** There will be a right shoulder closure on I-75 NB and SB at MP 188.68 from March 2, 2010 until April 1, 2010 for the I-75 bridge painting project. This is the I-75 bridge painting project. Motorists are advised to use caution when approaching the work zone.
- **Kyles Lane over I-75 Eastbound and Westbound -** There will also be a right shoulder closure on Kyles Lane over I-75 EB or WB starting on March 2, 2010 until April 1, 2010. This is the I-75 bridge painting project. Motorists are advised to use caution when approaching the work zone.
- **KY 1120 (12th Street Covington) –** Road Construction has begun on 12th Street in Covington. Construction activities will take place between the NB I-75 off ramp and Madison Ave. Barrier Wall will have been placed on EB 12th street. Street Parking will no longer be available on EB 12th Street. The south side of Lee and Fisk Streets are closed at their intersection with 12th street. Watch for traffic control devices and construction traffic entering and leaving the roadway. The speed limit throughout the work-zone will be 20 MPH.

- **John A. Roebling Suspension Bridge** – Beginning March 5, 2010 at 9:00 PM until Monday, March 8th at 5:00 AM the Roebling Bridge will be closed to vehicular traffic. A second weekend closure will take place from 9:00 PM March 12th until March 15th at 5:00 AM. The bridge will be permanently closed to vehicular traffic beginning April 7th. One sidewalk will remain open throughout the project for pedestrians. A detour will be marked utilizing the Clay Wade Bailey Bridge route.

OWEN COUNTY

- **KY 22 - Gratz Bridge (approximately at the 6 mile marker)** – The Gratz Bridge replacement is progressing, with some winter work taking place. Hauling of material is taking place as weather permits. The pier construction is nearly complete and some of the beams have been placed. Construction traffic can be expected on KY 22, and KY 355 in Owen County, and on KY 389 in Henry County. This project is being managed by the District 5 Office in Louisville. Kentucky River travelers should use caution near the bridge site.
