

NOTICE TO ALL POTENTIAL RESPONDENTS

The vendor questions and answers listed below are in direct relation to the following Request for Proposal: **Fire Facility Study**. This addendum is released on April 22nd, 2019 and officially updates, replaces, removes or clarifies certain portions of the City's issued Request for Proposal. Additional details are listed below.

VENDOR QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. Has an estimated budget been established for this project?

A. The City has not yet established a budget for this project, as we are in a very preliminary stage of analysis and design. It is the City's hope that through this study we will be able to identify a projected budget for this project.

Q. Would the City be willing to entertain a Vendor who utilizes a 3rd party provider for GIS data services?

A. Although the City would prefer to see responses from full service providers, we are not opposed to working with a provider who utilizes a 3rd party provider for GIS services. My suggestion would be to submit your proposal with the incorporated costs of collaborating with your 3rd party GIS provider. I would encourage you to select just one GIS provider that you feel confident can successfully provide the GIS services needed for this project.

Q. Can you provide a sample of your historic dispatch data as outlined in Task I – Site Location Analysis? We want to determine what field data can be used for geocoding (address, latitude and longitude or other). Additionally, how many historical dispatch records are there?

A. The City has the ability to access historical dispatch data, without issue. You will find a sample of this data attached as a separate file, titled "sample dispatch data set". This sample data should only be utilized in furtherance of the submission of a proposal for the RFP, *Fire Facility Study*, and for no other purposes. The City has immediate access to historical dispatch data dating back to 2012.
