Changes To Your Residential Waste & Recycling Billing

Covington Restores Residential Waste & Recycling Billing to City, Returns to Annual Payment

Based on feedback from property owners, the City is making changes to its residential waste & recycling billing practices.

Beginning in 2018 the City of Covington will directly bill property owners for waste & recycling services. Property owners will no longer receive quarterly bills from Rumpke. Instead, property owners will be billed annually for solid waste & recycling services. Residential waste & recycling bills will be issued by the City's Finance Department in March 2018.

These are the changes you will notice:

1. You will not receive quarterly invoices from Rumpke for waste & recycling services. **IMPORTANT: If you are currently signed up for auto debit with Rumpke, please cancel automatic payment effective, Jan. 1, 2018.**
2. The City is returning to an annual payment for waste & recycling services. Property owners will receive a bill from the City of Covington Finance Department on March 1, 2018, for the entire year (Jan. 2018 - Dec. 2018)
3. Residential waste & recycling payments are due to the City of Covington by March 31, 2018 to avoid any penalty. Checks should be made payable to:
