**EXECUTIVE ORDER
CITY OF COVINGTON, KENTUCKY**

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2021-EO-48

RESCIND PERMIT FEE WAIVERS (2020-EO-06)

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, Mayor Joseph U. Meyer signed Executive Order 2020-EO-01, declaring a state of emergency in the City of Covington due to the outbreak of COVID-19 virus, a public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, applicable Kentucky laws authorize a mayor to exercise emergency powers to efficiently and effectively provide for the health, safety and welfare of citizens; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Meyer previously entered Executive Order 2020-EO-06, effectively waiving permit fees associated with dumpster permits (Ordinance 96.15), encroachment permits (Ordinance 96.37) and zoning permits (Ordinance 150.12); and

WHEREAS, as the City of Covington emerges from the pandemic and the local, state and national economies rebound, the City must resume typical, pre-covid operations.

NOW and therefore, I, Joseph U. Meyer, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Covington, Kentucky by KRS Chapter 39A, KRS 39B, and in furtherance of the declaration set forth in Executive Order 2020-EO-01, hereby order that Executive Order 2020-EO-06 is repealed in its entirety and:

1. The fees associated with dumpster permits (Section 96.15), encroachment permits (Section 96.37) and zoning permits (150.12) are reinstated effective June 1, 2021.
2. Any project requiring a dumpster, encroachment, and/or zoning permit must obtain the appropriate permit(s) and the applicant shall pay the permit fee typically associated with the permit effective June 1, 2021.

This Order shall remain in effect until terminated by the issuance of another Executive Order when I determine that a state of emergency no longer exists and the exercise of extraordinary measures are no longer required for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE MAY 26, 2021 AND SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL RESCINDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER.
