AN ORDER ADOPTING THE NORTHERN KENTUCKY AREA  
DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (NKADD) REGIONAL HAZARD  
MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, certain areas of the City of Covington are subject to periodic flooding, tornados, severe winter storms, severe thunderstorms, and landslides and other natural hazards that have potential to cause damages to people and properties within the area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Covington desires to prepare and mitigate for such natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the NKADD Hazard Mitigation Plan was developed in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, to assist cities and counties in meeting this requirement, NKADD has facilitated the development of a multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of the NKADD including the City of Covington; and

WHEREAS, the City of Covington has participated in the Hazard Mitigation planning process.

Section 1

WHEREAS, the City previously received a CMAQ grant to construction the portion of the Riverfront Commons between Madison and Riverside Place; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is necessary to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the Department for Local Government recommended that the City apply for an additional amount of \$1,639,939.53 in CMAQ federal funding, which will require a match of 20%, or \$409,984.88 in City funds; and

WHEREAS, the City match portion is available in the Capital Bond Fund for use on the Riverfront Commons Project.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE GENERAL REVENUE AND LEVYING AND FIXING AN AD VALOREM TAX RATE ON ALL PROPERTY ASSESSED OR ASSESSABLE SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES IN THE CITY OF COVINGTON, KENTUCKY, TO MEET THE GENERAL EXPENSES OF SAID CITY; PROVIDING A SINKING FUND FOR PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF THE CITY; AND TO REDEEM BONDS MATURING DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE,  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON, KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year 2017-2018 a tax of \$0.327 upon each \$100.00 valuation of all assessed or assessable real property and \$0.349 upon each \$100.00 valuation of all assessed or assessable personal property subject to taxation for municipal purposes by the City of Covington, Kentucky, except bank shares, for the fiscal year 2016-2017 to be paid by the owners thereof or the person or corporation assessed, to meet the general expenses of the City of Covington and to provide funds to pay for public improvements, works or betterments and to create and provide a sinking fund for the payment of interest on the bonded indebtedness of the City; to redeem bonds maturing during the year 2017-2018; to create pension funds provided by law, and for other uses and purposes of the City of Covington during the fiscal year 2017-2018. Said tax of \$0.327 and \$0.349 for each \$100.00 valuation of all assessed or assessable property is levied in the following manner and for the following purposes:

Section 2

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year 2017-2018 a tax of the maximum amount allowed by the Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 135.270, upon each \$100.00 valuation of all assessed bank shares subject to taxation for municipal purposes by the City of Covington, Kentucky, to be paid into the general revenue funds of the City of

Covington, Kentucky. Any additional funds collected above the compensating rate will be placed in a reserved fund.

Section 3

That the taxes collected under the aforesaid levies are hereby apportioned to and for the exclusive uses and purposes hereinbefore set out and in accordance with the budget and ordinance apportioning and appropriating the revenues and receipts of the City of Covington, Kentucky, for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, submitted by the City Manager.

Section 4

That the revenue derived from all other sources shall be apportioned to the several departments for the uses and purposes provided for in the budget and appropriation for the current year, to make the difference in the funds, which the aforesaid rates will provide, and the total amount apportioned to such funds by said apportionment ordinance, so that the amounts produced by said rates and the amounts proportioned from revenue received from all other sources, shall make an amount sufficient to meet all the expenses, charges and appropriations and discharge the obligations of the City, created or incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

Section 5

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
