COMMISSIONERS' ORDINANCE NO. O-xx-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 111 OF THE COVINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, CREATING A NEW SUBCHAPTER PROHIBITING SEXUAL ORIENTATION AND GENDER IDENTITY CHANGE EFFORTS WITH A MINOR AND ESTABLISHING AN ASSOCIATED CIVIL PENALTY.

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At the conclusion of the Legislative Meeting, a Motion was made by Commissioner Williams to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to KRS 61.810(1)(g) discussions between a public agency and a representative of a business entity and discussions concerning a specific proposal. Second by Commissioner Downing. Motion passed 5-0.
